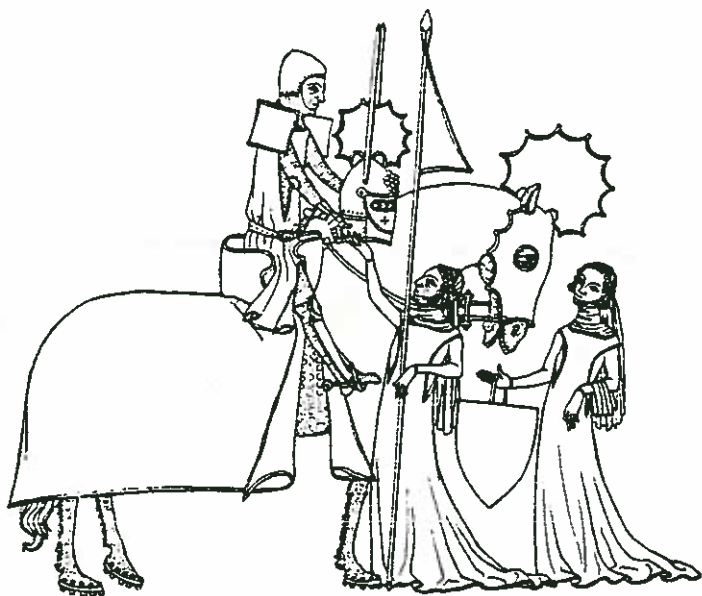

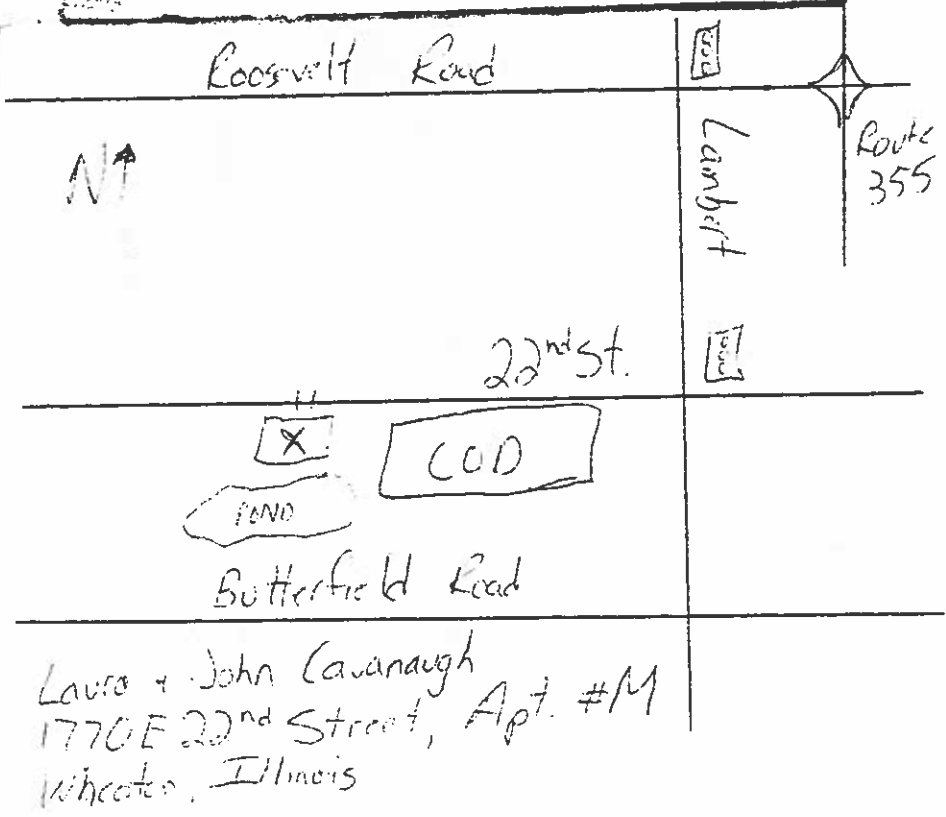

## BOOK REPORT

### THE MIDDLE AGES: A CONCISE ENCYCLOPAEDIA

Do you enjoy reading books about or set in the Middle Ages? (Of course, this is Chips). Do you ever find yourself wondering exactly what that person, place, movement or event is? Do you know who Boleslav I the Great is? How about the Beguines? How about Beatrice (d. 1290)? (She was the lady to whom Dante dedicated most of his poetry.) What is a Book of Hours? What were common burial customs? What are Edda the Elder & the Younger? What was considered to be a heresy? What was the Iconoclast movement? What was Jacquerie? If you ever wanted to know the answers to these questions or to learn a little more about your personnae's period and place without having to slog through a ton of history books to do so, then this book is for you.

The Middle Ages: A concise Encyclopaedia, edited by H.R. Lyon is exactly what its title implies. An encyclopaedia with short entries on a multitude of Medieval subjects. The book covers the years 400 to 1500 and Europe from Scandinavia to the Middle East. It includes biographies on many important people; current thought on items of background interest (e.g. Women, science, war, chivalry); maps; photographs; illustrations from manuscripts; a page depicting various styles of hand-writing, and dynastic charts. The Middle Ages is well written, cross-referenced with short bibliographies at the end of every article. Although, due to limited space, there are many subjects missing I found this to be a very informative and interesting book.

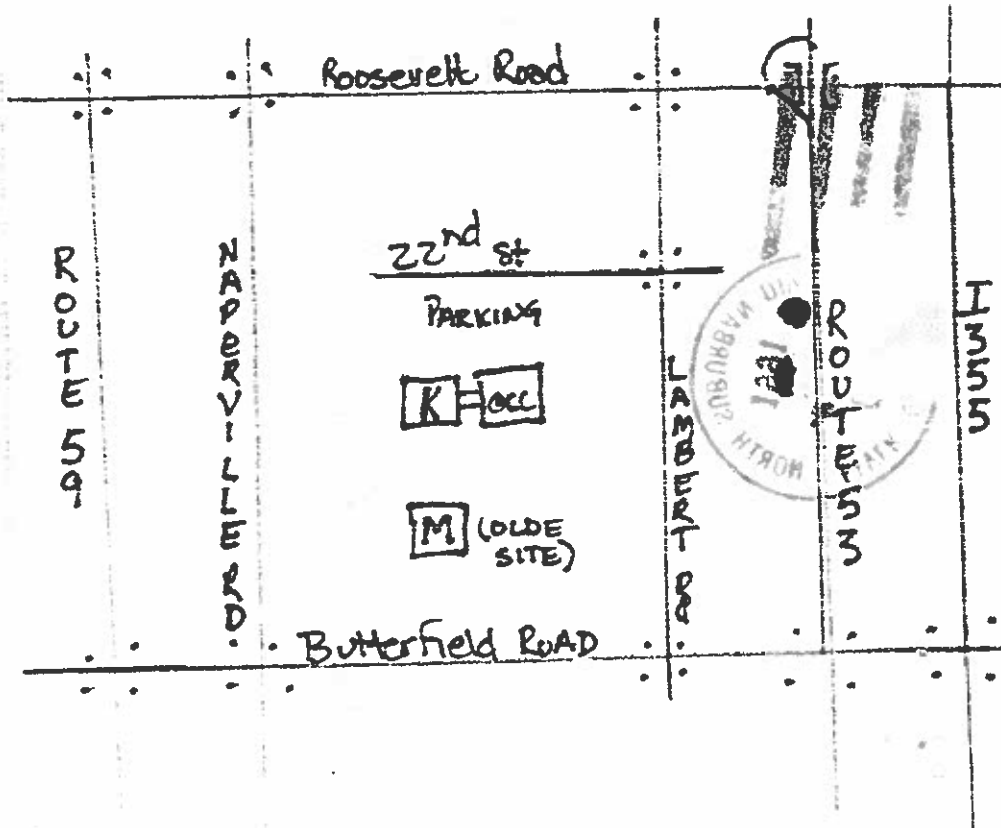


## MEDIEVAL MARKETPLACE

To get there take Rt. 21 south of 198 east 3 stoplights. Turn left on the access road that cuts between Valley Rental and the pet shop.

They've got lots of colors in lightweight cotton and several different weights of white fabric, some cotton/poly blends as well. And it's still at the same great price: \$1.00 a pound! I bought 29 pounds of assorted stuff, I was charged for 28#. But be advised, cash only.

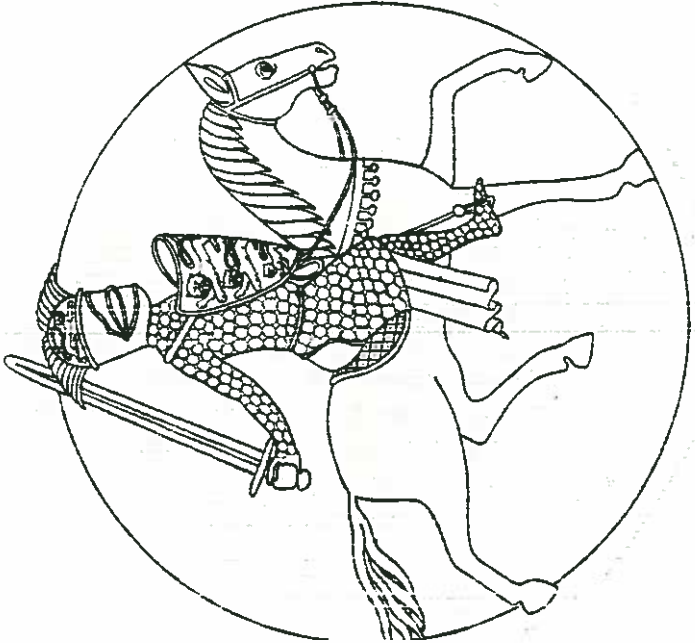
